TCC/2356 CONSULTATION PROCESS AND PLANNING FORWARD

A verbal summary of the resolutions made at the previous full Council meeting was received. It was noted that the Clerk had begun the Community Ownership Fund Expression of interest and had obtained quotes for a structural audit to bring to full Council for approval. It was noted that the wording of the fact sheet "what the new building will be used for" will be phrased "what the new building could be used for".

The Committee invited Borough Cllr Rob Baker and S. Rose of the Cricket Club to discuss the tabled Tintwistle Community Hub Proposal to convert the existing cricket club pavilion into a community hall. Questions arising from the proposal included: At what stage is the process of developing a carpark for the Cricket Club currently at? What is the expected timescale for applying for the Shared Prosperity fund? What is a small public amenities block, as referenced in the proposal? How many parking places can be created at the Cricket Club and does the meet the legal requirements to the building size? Would the name of the venue be changed? Where would the Clerk work from and where would the confidential documents be stored? Would the space be available and accessible during working hours? What would be the size of the space available and is it suitable to support the current activities.

RESOLVED: To bring the proposal to full Council and request that Cllr Baker delivers a full presentation following further research into the processes involved.
